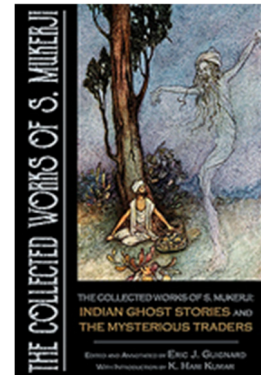
THE COLLECTED WORKS OF S. MUKERJI: INDIAN GHOST STORIES AND THE MYSTERIOUS TRADERS
